**Responsibilities:**

- Assure the provision of quality primary care services to Chester County families, including clinical, advocacy, case management and facilitation services.
- Advocate for and assure credentialing with third party payers for self and other CRNP as needed
- Advance the role of the advance practice nurse and the nursing center as a model of primary health care for vulnerable communities.
- The CRNP position at Project Salud is a full– time position of 37.5 hours per week; including one evening (Part-time hours available).
- The CRNP will shares on-call services for weekends, after hours, and holidays.

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**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Provide counseling for clients seeking HIV information and testing.
- Provide screening for primary care and behavioral health problems.
- Provide health coaching in order to assist patients set and achieve health goals.
- Diagnosis and management chronic diseases.
- Evaluation and treatment of acute episodic and chronic illnesses.
- Evaluation and treatment of injuries.
- Provision of immunizations, flu vaccines and physical examinations.
- Provision of HIV/AIDS testing, counseling, and referral.
- Physical therapy evaluation and treatment.
- Assess real and potential health problems with regard to life style behaviors, occupational hazards, and genetic predisposition; provide information and counseling as needed.
- Follow up of clients having abnormal lab or imaging results.
- Follow up of clients referred to specialty services.
- Identify pharmaceutical assistance programs for eligible clients, complete forms and submit in a timely fashion.
- Participate in case management meetings.
- Update and maintain the medical protocols manual
- Identify the need for and initiate the development of medical

protocols for specified health problems. Participate in Quality Assurance reviews and analysis.

- Participate in community outreach and education programs as requested.
- Assure confidentiality of patient information in accordance with HIPAA regulations.
- Conduct biweekly patient oriented consultation meetings with the physician- consultant/collaborator.
- Works with Practice Manager to help identify continuing education needs for clinical and support staff.
